

Grading and Progress Reports – Elementary

In kindergarten and grades 1-5 a combination of parent conferences and report cards or progress reports are used for reporting student progress to parents. Teacher/parent conferences are held in both the first and second semesters. The Student Report card is used in conjunction with the conferences.

Students are evaluated as follows:

1. Kindergarten and grades 1-3
 - O -- Outstanding performance
 - S -- Satisfactory performance
 - N -- Needs improvement
2. Kindergarten and grades 1-4
 - Reading at Grade Level – Yes/No
3. Grades 4-5
 - a. Personal/Work & Study Skills/Fine Arts/Physical Education
 - O -- Outstanding performance
 - S -- Satisfactory performance
 - N -- Needs improvement
 - b. Academic Achievement
 - A -- Excellent
 - B -- Good
 - C -- Average
 - D -- Below average
 - I -- Incomplete/Not Passing
4. No mark indicates that a particular area is not being evaluated during the current reporting period.
