

CPSD POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Swimming Pool Operations:

- Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of patrons and CPSD property. Patrons must follow staff directions to insure safe environment for all.
- **A CLEANSING SHOWER IS REQUIRED BEFORE POOL ENTRY.**
- Please **WALK** at all times while on deck, running and horseplay are prohibited.
- **NO DIVING** in the Lap pool.
- Food and beverages must be consumed in designated seating area. **GLASS IS NOT PERMITTED.**
- Use by anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
- Patrons may not use the swimming pool with opened or bandaged wounds.
- Patrons with a communicable disease and/or anyone who has been ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last 2 weeks are prohibited from pool use.
- Anyone with a seizure, heart or circulatory problems should swim with a buddy.
- Patrons requiring use of diapers must wear a protective covering to prevent contamination. **Diapers must be changed in locker rooms.**
- Patrons refusing to obey the pool rules are subject to removal from the premises.

Open/Lap Swimming Rules:

- Lap swimming/lap lanes are available for patrons 16 years of age and older and swim team members.
- Non swimmers under 4'2" tall must be accompanied by an adult or guardian 16 years of age or older.
- Children 12 years of age or less must be accompanied by a responsible adult (18 years of age or older) at the pool facility and on the pool deck at all times the child is in the pool.
- If an individual between 13 and 17 years of age is using the pool, there must be at least one other person accompanying them at the pool facility.
- Children under the age of 16 must pass the swim test to use the deep tank.
 - *Swim Test: Tread water for 30 seconds and swim 25 yards without stopping or touching the bottom.*

Diving Board Rules:

- Only one person at a time allowed on the diving board.
- Only one bounce on the diving board is allowed.
- No sitting on the diving board.
- Diver must swim to the nearest ladder after diving off board.
- Patrons may dive from side of deck or swim in the deep tank if there is no one using the diving board.
